ORDER:

In the letter second read above, the Director of Legal Studies (FAC)/Competent Authority has forwarded an application and other relevant particulars received from Pushpavathi Ammal Educational Trust at Karur District seeking ‘No Objection Certificate’ for establishing a Self-financing Private Law College in the name and style of “Dhanvanth Law College” at Karur- Erode main Road, Athur Post, Karur, Karur District. The Director of Legal Studies (FAC) has stated that the location proposed by the said Pushpavathi Ammal Trust for the establishment of Self-financing Private Law College at Karur- Erode main Road, Athur Post, Karur, Karur District was inspected by a Committee headed by her and has certified that the aforesaid Trust has fulfilled the requirements stipulated in the Tamil Nadu Establishment of Private Law Colleges (Regulation) Act, 2018 (Tamil Nadu Act 22 of 2018) and submitted all the documents required in the said Act for starting a Private Law College and has recommended to grant permission to the aforesaid Trust to establish a Self-financing Private Law College.

2. The Government, after careful consideration of the application of the Pushpavathi Ammal Educational Trust at Karur District, the relevant documents, the Inspection Committee’s Report and the recommendation of the Director of Legal Studies (FAC)/Competent Authority, have decided to accord permission under the Tamil Nadu Establishment of Private Law Colleges (Regulation) Act, 2018 (Tamil Nadu Act 22 of 2018) to the said Trust to establish a Self-financing Private Law College in the name and style of “Dhanvanth Law College” in the temporary building at Karur- Erode main Road, Athur Post, Karur, Karur District and accordingly grant permission, subject to the following terms and conditions, namely:-

- (i) Affiliation from the Tamil Nadu Dr.Ambedkar Law University and approval from the Bar Council of India shall be obtained before the commencement of the courses;
- (ii) The Trust shall follow the Rule of Reservation as per the laws in force in the admission of students in the Law College;
- (iii) The Trust shall surrender such number of seats in the College, to be filled up by the Government, as required under the Tamil Nadu Admission in Professional Educational Institutions Act, 2006 (Tamil Nadu Act 3 of 2007);

(iv) Tuition Fee including special fee shall be collected from the students only at the rates prescribed by the Fee Committee constituted vide G.O.(Ms.)No.295, Law(LS) Department, dated 02.11.2018;

(v) Capitation Fee or any other fee in the form of donation shall not be collected from the students;

(vi) The Trust shall commence the course within a period of three years from the date of issue of this order;

(vii) The Trust shall also follow the orders in regard to admission of students to Private Law Colleges issued by the Government from time to time;

(viii) The plan for the permanent building in which the law college is to be established i.e., Blue Print approved by the competent authority shall be produced along with "master plan", for the entire institutional complex with the details of the plinth area including area of class rooms, moot court hall, administrative block, library, hostel etc., within six months from the date of issue of the Government Order;

(ix) License granted by the competent authority under the Tamil Nadu Public Buildings (Licensing) Act, 1965 (Tamil Nadu Act 13 of 1965) for the said permanent building shall be produced before it is actually put to use;

(x) A suitable devise or document shall be executed by the Trust to the satisfaction of the Competent Authority/Director of Legal Studies confirming that the amount to the tune of rupees thirty lakhs deposited under the term deposit No.207980212 has been endowed for the purpose of obtaining permission to start a law college by the said Trust;

(xi) The Trust shall produce an undertaking to the Competent Authority / Director of Legal Studies ensuring that the books for the Library of the proposed Law College are purchased and readily available in the Library before making application for affiliation from the Tamil Nadu Dr.Ambedkar Law University.
